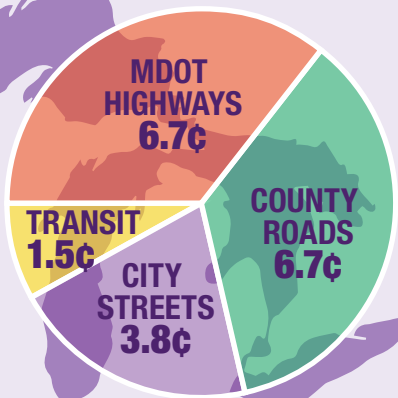
MI SALES TAX 6%

STATE GAS TAX

Gas taxes per gallon stay the same with the price of gas, so as gas prices go up, less gasoline is purchased and these **ROAD REVENUES DECLINE!**

Sales tax fluctuates with the price of gas. As gas prices go up, revenues collected increase **BUT NOT FOR ROADS!**
