



Tri-County Regional Planning Commission FY 2017 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendments Schedule

Critical Dates for Changes to the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission 2017-2020 TIP

Changes or amendments to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) start with a request from the responsible agency to Tri-County Regional Planning Commission (TCRPC). Agencies follow their own rules regarding public and official approvals before requesting an amendment.

TCRPC staff ensure a request is complete and transmit it to the region's transportation committees for public review. The Capital Area Regional Transportation Study (CARTS) Committee, a technical committee of transportation engineers and planners, and the Transportation Review Committee, TCRPC's policy committee, consider the request. With both committees' recommendations, and public input, the full board of the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission decides to accept or reject the change.

Approved amendments are processed by TCRPC staff as soon as possible and are then sent to the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) for review and then to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and/or Federal Transit Administration. FHWA issues amendment approvals every two months. MDOT and FHWA/FTA review of the TIP amendments can take up to a month from TCRPC action until approval. Amendments to the TIP are not official until FHWA approves our region's revised TIP.
